2. INTRODUCTION

This web developer's guide contains a description of the 2B Advice PrIME Cookie Consent Manager and instructions for placing a cookie banner and statement on the website. Please ensure that you have the required admin level permissions to add scripts to the website.

The Cookie Consent Manager is a component of 2B Advice PrIME that can be used in "processing activities" registered in 2B Advice Data Privacy Software system. Cookie Consent Manager provides comprehensive management of website cookies in compliance with applicable privacy laws. As part of that compliance, the Cookie Consent Manager provides five JavaScript snippets that must be integrated into the website. These scripts provide the following functionality with regard to online cookie management:

- **Cookie Consent Dialog**—the consent dialog, usually called a "cookie banner" is displayed as an overlay on the webpage in the web browser of the website visitor. It can be positioned at the top or bottom of the active screen. Or on the left or right margin. This dialog allows the user to accept all cookies, or by reviewing settings the visitor can disallow certain categories of cookies that are not vital to the core functionality of the website.
- **Cookie Policy**—the cookie policy text is inserted in the website's HTML Privacy Declaration. The text of the Cookie Policy portion of the Privacy policy can be controlled entirely from within Cookie Consent Manager, and then rendered dynamically on the Privacy Policy page. This is necessary so that the list of currently active cookies can be dynamically displayed on the Privacy Declaration page. Portions of the cookie policy can be expressed statically on the HTML page, but for the sake of continuity it is advised that the Cookie Consent Manager contain the entire cookie policy section of the Privacy Declaration.
- **Policy/Privacy statement** - the general privacy declaration text is inserted in the website's HTML policy declaration. It is rendered dynamically on the Policy page.
- **Opt-in/opt-out consent** - will provide the feature to obtain/disclose or delete the consent for personal information under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA). The opt-in/opt-out consent can be obtained or revoked by using the form, shown in the consent and submitting it.
- **Opt-in/opt-out consent confirmation** - display confirmation message about submitted opt-in/opt-out consents. (Only applicable when you are using your own website for consent confirmation)
- **Whistleblowing form** – displays the whistleblowing form on a website.

3. COOKIE STATEMENT

3.1 IMPLEMENTATION PREREQUISITES

Before you start the implementation please observe the prerequisites and recommendations below:

The website on which the cookie banner is to be implemented must be accessible via the internet without authentication. Websites that are protected by authentication cannot be used.

In order for the cookie banner to be implemented, a scan of the website must be performed. The crawler comes from the address <https://prime-psf.2B Advice.com> and must not be blocked.

In the analysis and the statement, subdomains of [www.\[YourDomain\].com](http://www.[YourDomain].com) (e.g. [shop.\[YourDomain\].com](http://shop.[YourDomain].com), [careers.\[YourDomain\].com](http://careers.[YourDomain].com)) can be combined in one statement. It is a prerequisite that the option “Include sub-domains” is activated in the statement. Furthermore there have to be links from the main domain to the sub-domains. If the links do not exist, a separate statement must be created for the sub-domains.

The cookie statement is only valid for the domain defined in the statement. This domain must be contained in the referrer. Therefore, the referrer policy must contain one of the following values:

- no-referrer-when-downgrade
- origin
- origin-when-cross-origin
- strict-origin
- strict-origin-when-cross-origin

The cookie script loads other scripts. This must be allowed. Please note that this prerequisite makes it necessary that the referrer policy mentioned above must be valid for the complete website. Assigning it to the integration script alone is not sufficient.

Note for testing: There may be company policies that influence the configuration of web browsers or transmitted data. Through them, cookies can be filtered out independently of our cookie consent. To make sure that they do not have any side effects on the cookie consent, we recommend to test over unrestricted internet connections.

3.2 COOKIE CONSENT DIALOG SCRIPT INTEGRATION

The snippet for this script will only be generated when the Cookie Dialog has been fully configured and the statement has been published. The active snippet can be obtained by logging into the 2B Advice PrIME Cookie Consent Manager and clicking the Settings tab. Typically your privacy manager or legal counsel will have generated the script and forwarded it to you.

NOTE: Cookie Consent Manager can manage cookies for more than one domain. Ensure that the scanned statement domain matches the domain of the website where this script is being installed.

This snippet has to be installed on each page of the website in the <head> section, before any other scripts. This is necessary so the Cookie Consent Manager can prevent other scripts from downloading cookies before consent has been obtained as required by GDPR.

For websites developed using Content Management Systems such as WordPress, Drupal or others the site theme often provides an opportunity in the theme general settings to provide script code to be inserted in the head section of every page when the page is dynamically generated. Again, the Consent Dialog Script must be inserted at the top of this dialog window so that Cookie Consent Manager loads first. If the theme does not provide this capability, there are plugins available.

3.3 COOKIE POLICY SCRIPT INTEGRATION

The Cookie Policy Script can be inserted in a static HTML page. It also is available under the Settings tab of the Cookie Statement registered with a processing activity. The script takes the following form:

The cookie policy appears in the location where the script element is entered. Alternatively it may be entered anywhere on a website with attribute “data-rendermode” but then has to call the API as described in the [chapter 6.3.4](#).

The cookie policy script element can be invoked with the with attribute “data-rendermode”:

The attribute “data-rendermode” has following options:

- auto – The cookie policy is rendered on place of the script tag (default rendering mode).
- ondemand – The cookie policy is rendered by calling the API function “bbCookieApi.renderCookieDeclaration”. The argument “parentNode” defines the HTML element where the cookie policy is inserted.

NOTE: Please consider that the cookie policy also requires the integration of the Cookie Consent dialog script described in the [chapter 3.1](#).

3.4 MANUALLY TAGGING THE SCRIPTS FOR COOKIE CONSENT

One can manually create script-tags which can be disabled/enabled for the Cookie Consent.

Set the script-tag attribute to ***data-bbcc=“Cookie_Category_Identifier”***.

The value for the attribute “data-bbcc” is the identifier for the cookie statement category that is displayed on the “Cookie Consent” tab page for the “Cookie Statement” in the 2B Advice PrIME application.

3.5 DISABLE BLOCKING PROCESS FOR SCRIPTS

In some cases, it is necessary to disable blocking of certain scripts. Such behavior can be achieved when the script HTML tag is marked with the category name "ignore". All scripts with the attribute ***data-bbcc="ignore"*** are ignored by Cookie Consent Manager and always executed without any restrictions.

Examples how to mark a script with the ignore category:

3.6 GOOGLE TAG MANAGER INTEGRATION

If your website is using Google Tag Manager (GTM), you can deploy cookie consent easily with our predefined 2BCookie Consent Manager template in just few steps.

- Login to your GTM container and navigate to Templates
- In Tag Templates section click on Search Gallery
- Search for 2BCookie Consent Manager and add it to the workspace
- Now you must create a new tag using this template. For this, go to Tags, click on New > Tag Configuration and select our template.
- Enter your Statement ID in the required field.

- Now your tag is all set and ready to go; you can publish your container and try it out.

It is important to take in account that when you integrate our cookie consent via the 2BCookie Consent Manager template it won't be able to automatically block other script tags that do not come from GTM. To again enable this functionality, you must manually assign categories for these scripts. This can be done by changing script type from "text/javascript" to "text/plain" and adding data-bbcc attribute with corresponding category. By setting the script type to "text/plain" it won't be executed right away after user visits your page for the first time but only after s/he provides consent for required category.

To facilitate this process, you can use the report available in PrIME application. In this report you can see which cookie was set by which script along with line number where the script is located and category it belongs to.

3.6.1 Google Consent Mode

Google Consent Mode is a functionality that allows your website to notify GTM about visitors consent and run tags based on given consent. Our Cookie Consent Manager is fully integrated with this feature and to fire your tags based on visitor consent all you have to do is modify the tag trigger and add required consent. To do this, open your tag and in Tag Configuration, and expand Consent Settings. Enable "Require additional consent for tag to fire", and in the input field enter required consent type.

By default, Google provides following consent types:

Consent Type	Description
ad_storage	Enables storage (such as cookies) related to advertising
analytics_storage	Enables storage (such as cookies) related to analytics e.g. visit duration
functionality_storage	Enables storage that supports the functionality of the website or app e.g. language settings
personalization_storage	Enables storage related to personalization e.g. video recommendations
security_storage	Enables storage related to security such as authentication functionality, fraud prevention, and other user protection

These types map to our standard categories in the following way:

- ad_storage = marketing
- analytics_storage = statistic
- functionality_storage & personalization_storage = preferences
- security_storage = necessary (is always enabled)

For example, if you want to fire your tag when user gives consent to marketing category when visiting your page, add ad_storage to the "Require additional consent for tag to fire" field.

Additionally, if you have specified any custom categories when creating your Cookie Statement in PrIME application and you want to fire GTM tag when user provides consent for this category use category identifier.

Google Consent Manager grants consent for any custom category by default. To change this behavior, you must modify our 2BCookie Consent Manager template a little bit. Follow these steps:

- In GTM navigate to Templates and select 2BCookie Consent Manager
- Go to Code tab page and add your category in the following format: 'category_identifier': 'denied' as shown on the following image. Again, use category identifier from the 2B Advice PrIME application.





7 LANGUAGES

It is possible to provide a Cookie Consent Dialog or Privacy Declaration in multiple languages. It will then be displayed based on the selected **browser** language or a **user defined** language. This will present the cookie banner, dialog and policy in a different language to the web site visitor.

Browser language

By default, the browser language is used for finding the appropriate localization of cookie banner, cookie dialog and policy text.

Specific language

To set a specific language, a Cookie Consent Dialog Script or Privacy Declaration Script must contain the attribute "data-language". The value for this attribute must be the two letter ISO 639-1 code (en, de, sk, it, ...).

Additional translations have to be prepared in the 2B Advice PrIME application. If the localization for the required language doesn't exist, the following process is applied for both cases:

The application checks if an English version is available. In case that the English localization doesn't exist, the system uses the first available language of the published statement in the sequence German, French, Italian.

8 API DOCUMENTATION

This chapter documents the implementation of 2B Advice Cookie Consent Framework.

8.1 COOKIE CONSENT CALLBACKS

A callback is any executable code that is passed as an argument to other code; that other code is expected to call back (execute) the argument at a given time (hence the name “call back”). For example, when some action has to be executed after a Cookie Consent Manager action e.g. after click on the “Accept” button. Here is the list of supported callback functions implemented for Cookie Consent Manager:

- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnLoad** – this asynchronous callback fires when the cookie consent loads to get the user's consent.
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnDialogInit** - this asynchronous callback fires when the cookie consent banner initializes. It fires before the execution of the content of cookie banner.
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnDialogDisplay** - this asynchronous callback fires when the cookie consent banner is displayed on the website.
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnAccept** - this asynchronous callback fires when the user accepts the cookie consent (after the user clicks the “Accept all” button in the cookie banner or the “Accept” button in the cookie settings dialog).
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnDecline** – this asynchronous callback fires when the website visitor only accepts necessary/mandatory cookies (after the user clicks the “decline” button in the cookie banner).
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnWithdraw** - this asynchronous callback fires when the user withdraws the consent (after the user clicks the “Withdraw your consent link”).
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnDialogSettingsInit** – this asynchronous callback fires before the cookie consent settings dialog initializes. It fires before the execution of the content of cookie consent setting dialog.
- **BBCookieManagerCallbackOnDialogSettingsDisplay** – this asynchronous callback fires when the cookie consent settings dialog is displayed on the website.

Example:

When a user clicks on the button "Accept" the current cookie consent is checked. If the category "statistic" is enabled, then a new cookie is set for a website with geolocation.

8.2 COOKIE CONSENT EVENTS

A cookie consent event is an event that executes after another cookie consent function has finished. Here is the list of supported cookie events implemented for the Cookie Consent Manager:

onLoad: "BBCookieManagerOnLoad"

- It fires when the cookie consent loads to get the user's consent.

onDialogInit: "BBCookieManagerOnDialogInit"

- It fires before the execution of the content of cookie banner.

onDialogDisplay: "BBCookieManagerOnDialogDisplay"

- It fires when the cookie consent banner is displayed on the website.

onAccept: "BBCookieManagerOnAccept"

- It fires when a web page visitor accepts the cookie consent (after clicking the "Accept all" button in the cookie banner or the "Accept" button in the cookie settings dialog).

onDecline: "BBCookieManagerOnDecline"

- It fires when a web page visitor accepts only the necessary/mandatory cookies (after clicking the decline button in the cookie banner).

onWithdraw: "BBCookieManagerOnWithdraw"

- It fires when a website visitor withdraws the consent (after clicking the "Withdraw your consent link").

onDialogSettingsInit: "BBCookieManagerOnDialogSettingsInit"

- It fires before the execution of the content of the cookie consent setting dialog.

onDialogSettingsDisplay: "BBCookieManagerOnDialogSettingsDisplay"

- fires when the cookie consent settings dialog displays on the website.

The appended DOM element is disabled (e.g. script DOM element has attribute “text/plain” and the iframe DOM element does not have the “src” attribute). To enable appended DOM elements, the API function “runSrcTags” described in the [chapter 6.3.6](#) must be called.

8.3.6 runSrcTags()

Description:

This function detects all tags of type="text/plain" and enables/executes the tags according to the visitor's consent.

If script tags or any other tags with "src" attribute are not present in the website during the parsing process but are added dynamically (e.g. by button click or in context of a SPA), then the Cookie Consent Manager cannot process those elements. In this case, the scripts and src tags can be inserted to the website using the API function "[appendSrcTag](#)" or manually by setting type="text/plain" and the appropriate category specified in the "data-bbcc" attribute. When the API function "runSrcTags" is called, it detects all tags of type "text/plain" and enables them according to the current consent.

9 CUSTOMIZING THE TEMPLATES FOR COOKIE BANNER, COOKIE DIALOG AND COOKIE DECLARATION LIST

You can adapt some parts of cookie banner, cookie consent dialog and cookie declaration list to your corporate identity.

9.1 STYLING THE COOKIE CONSENT DIALOG

The style of a Cookie Consent Dialog is editable. You can change the style by overwriting the Cascading Style Sheet (CSS) rules. These can be built into a stand-alone style sheet that can be inserted into the page header to load after the main style sheet. For CMS systems, they can be built into a child theme, or if the theme allows it, they can be inserted in theme settings. In general this inserts them in the header on the rendered page, so that they override the external style sheet. Positioning rules and media queries etc. should be avoided. To identify the proper selectors, developers should render the page with the embedded Cookie Consent Dialog. They can then use the browser's development tools to inspect the elements and to ensure that the employed selectors for that site are correct.






Figure 9 Left banner






Figure 16 Cookie settings dialog




Figure 19 Cookie settings dialog menu




Figure 21 Cookie settings dialog description




Figure 26 Base cookie banner




Figure 28 Base cookie consent dialog




Figure 29 Cookie consent dialog after change
